## Call for Action on recurring floods experienced by family farmers during the last agricultural campaigns

I am speaking today in my capacity as President of the West African Farmers' and Producers' Organizations Network (ROPPA) and the Pan-African Organization of Producers (PAFO) to talk about **the dramatic situation of farmers in the Sahel region and many other regions on the continent following unprecedented floods for at least sixty years.**

Our tools (Family Farm Observatory) alert on the large number of small producers affected by this phenomenon during this agro-sylvo season and fisheries.
  Most were already suffering from insecurity that has been going on for several years.
  This crisis is destroying the efforts made by governments, IGOs, development partners and farmers.
